


Netflix Announces Animated Series Based on Scholastic's 'Magic School Bus'

The Magic School Bus is heading back to television -- Netflix and Scholastic Media announced Wednesday that a new, original series based on the kids' science series will bow in 2016.

The Magic School Bus 360° will be a computer-generated reimagining of the 1990s show, complete with 26 episodes that star a modernized Ms. Frizzle and her students. They'll navigate problemsolving adventures in a high-tech bus with features like robotics, wearables and camera technology, reads the announcement.
